



The Advancement Of Laser Therapy

As many of us already know, lasers are being used for many medical purposes from corrective eye surgery to skin treatments; Lasers also have a necessary use in the treatment of gum disease. It has long been known that proper treatment for active gum infections is not only the removal of tartar and bacterial toxins from the tooth but also removal of the diseased tissue itself.

The dental laser provides this function by killing bacteria deep under the gum line and along the root surface. It gently removes dead and diseased tissue surrounding the tooth leaving healthy tissue to grow and attach to the tooth. This reduces the overall gum pocket depth, allowing for easier home care and easier dental cleanings! This procedure is performed with the use of topical anesthetic and is usually done during your cleaning appointment.

The results are amazing and if properly maintained can last a lifetime.
